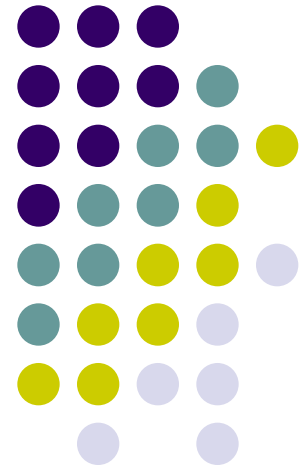

Welcome to EBSCO's Conducting an Advanced Guided Style search on EBSCOhost tutorial. In this tutorial, we will look at conducting an Advanced Search on EBSCOhost, using the Guided Style Find fields as well as applying limiters and expanders.

Guided Style searching allows you to simultaneously search for different terms in varying article citation fields. Begin by entering a search term in the first **Find** field, and then select which field(s) to search from the drop-down list, such as **Subject Terms**.

Guide your search using a second term and choose the **All Text** field to have EBSCOhost look within the full text of all articles for your term. **Note:** You can conduct command line searches using the appropriate field tags, e.g., **SO** for Journal Name, in front of the search term in the **Find** field.
