

Application Process

- 1. Before completion, ensure that you have read the <u>Course and Fee Information</u> published on the Whitehouse Institute of Design website.
- 2. If you are applying as a domestic student and are under the age of 18 discuss your with your Parent / Guardian they are to complete and sign on pages 3, 5 and 6 before your enrolment is submitted. Overseas students must be 18 or older at the time of course commencement.
- 3. Read the breakdown of tuition fees on page 3 and select one payment option on page 4.
- 4. Read the information on **Unique Student Identifier (USI)** on page 6 and select one option on page 3.
- 5. Attach a copy of identification (Medicare card, birth certificate, driver licence, Australian passport, citizenship document, certificate of registration by descent, ImmiCard or Australian entry visa).
- 6. If you are applying as an overseas student attach copies of the photograph page of your passport, current student visa if you have it and your English academic standard IELTS/TOEFL score

- If I withdraw from my studies at Whitehouse without formal notification, and/or if my conduct or course progress is deemed unsuitable or my course progress is unsatisfactory (non-progression), my enrolment will be cancelled. Privacy - Unique Student identifier (USI) Creation/Registration

If we apply for a USI on your behalf the Registrar will verify your identity. The Registrar will do so through the Document Verification Service (DVS) managed by the Attorney-General's Department which is built into the USI online application process if you have documents such as a Medicare card, birth certificate, driver licence, Australian passport, citizenship document, certificate of registration by descent, ImmiCard or Australian entry visa.

If you ask Whitehouse to make an application for a student identifier on your behalf, Whitehouse will have to declare that we have complied with certain terms and conditions to be able to access the online student identifier portal and submit this application, including a declaration that Whitehouse has given you the following privacy notice.
