


Policy Name	FREE INTELLECTUAL INQUIRY POLICY

Purpose	The purpose of this policy is to provide direction on free intellectual inquiry within Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses at Whitehouse Institute of Design, Australia (Whitehouse).
Scope	This policy applies to all staff delivering VET courses and VET students across all Whitehouse delivery sites.
