Purpose	<ul> <li>The purpose of this policy is to:</li> <li>acknowledge the right of students to raise and have addressed academic grievances and appeals.</li> </ul>		
Scope	This policy applies to all students, employees and contractors involved in the provision of teaching and learning in vocational education and training courses at the Whitehouse Institute of Design, Australia (Whitehouse).		
Policy Statement	<ul> <li>Whitehouse will work to ensure that an academic grievance and appeals process is conducted:</li> <li>fairly</li> <li>impartially</li> <li>transparently, and</li> <li>in a timely manner.</li> </ul> All students have the right to lodge informal and/or formal grievances and appeals against academic or administrative decisions affecting them. Any grievances, complaints and appeals will be taken seriously and handled professionally and in accordance with the Whitehouse VET Academic Grievance and Appeals Procedures in order to achieve a prompt resolution. There is a clear and transparent step by step procedure for the resolution of grievances and appeals. A student may seek assistance and advice in relation to the appeals process from the Campus Wellbeing officer, which will direct them to the appropriate procedures.
