The total course fee is \$4,250.00 and includes: a deposit of \$400.00 + tuition fees of \$3,850.00:

Qualification Description:

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who are developing a broad range of technical and conceptual design skills and who take responsibility for own outputs in work and learning. Practice at this level is underpinned by the application of introductory design theory and history.

Course Structure:

The Units of Competency in the Certificate III in Design Fundamentals CUA30720 have been selected and sequenced to ensure sound pedagogical development of skills over the duration of the course. Some Units have been clustered for delivery and assessment. Students can select one of three specialist focus areas – Fashion Visualisation, Interior Visualisation, or Creative Direction Visualisation.

Certificate III in Design Fundamentals Qualification: Completion of 12 Units being 7 core units plus, 5 elective units (2years). Students who exit the course before completion will be eligible for Statement of Attainment (SoA) for completed units.
